

BIG WIN FOR DS AVOCATS CANADA IN ANTIDUMPING DISPUTE ON BEHALF OF CANADIAN PRODUCER IN MINING GRINDING MEDIA

DS Avocats Canada LLP served as counsel to Canadian producer Magotteaux Limitée of Magog Québec, in a dispute over unfairly dumped and subsidized imports of high-chrome cast grinding balls in Canada by the Indian exporter AIA Engineering/Vega USA. This protects and secures Magotteaux's Canadian market against erosion caused by unfair trade. Magotteaux is a global leader in grinding media solutions, notably for Canada's mining industry.

In its decision announced on August 27, 2021, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal confirmed that Indian imports had caused material injury to the Canadian industry following an earlier finding by the Canada Border Services Agency establishing 22% ad valorem anti-dumping and countervailing duties to remedy economic harm suffered by Magotteaux. This effort concluded a year-long investigation into the harmful business practices of Indian exporters in Canada.

The decision is another excellent success for DS Avocats' International Trade Law team and consolidates its standing as a Canadian leader in International Trade and Customs Law by protecting Canadian industry and jobs against unfair trade practices.
